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ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The After-School Program will run from **Monday, November 18, 2019** through **June 2020**. Classes will be offered Mondays through Thursdays from 3:30 pm to 6:00 pm. The first hour will be dedicated to reviewing material and solving problems with TAs, and the remainder of the time will be dedicated to having Instructors from The City College of New York work with both students and TAs to provide support for classroom material and homework.

Students will have the option of signing up for any two of four available courses. We highly recommend for students to take one math class along with an additional second course. *Elective course availability is contingent upon enrollment.*

This year's available course offerings are:

Algebra I	Geometry
Living Environment	Earth Science

Students should register for math and science courses based on the courses they are currently taking in school, as the after-school program is designed to enhance their fundamental understanding of mathematical principals and the materials covered in their high school classes. This program is also designed to help prepare students to excel in the classroom, on Regents' exams, and on standardized tests, like the SATs.

Course content will vary and depend highly on students' needs. Please keep in mind that each course will be offered two days per week, giving students the opportunity to take one course two days per week and another course on the remaining two days.
